By Law personnel who sling loads to be lifted must have Dogging Certification if the load to be lifted requires:

- 1. An estimation of its weight. 2. Judgment on its centre of gravity. 3. Correct selection of slings to be used. 4. Method of slinging to be used.

Overall Aim:

At the completion of this course applicants will have the ability to safely carry out dogging duties. The valuable skills learned on this course will enable applicants to complete every aspect of load lifting with confidence. National Worksafe accreditation is issued on successful completion.

Delivery method:

Training is conducted in the classroom & in the field. 3 x 8 hour Classroom. 1 x 8 Hour Practical
