



CRE Scholarships 2011

Cowan Regional Grants

Cowan Regional grants are available to assist commencing students studying full time at the Whyalla Campus and the Mt Gambier Regional Centre.

The grants assist students with the costs associated with full time study including study, living and travel expenses. Students must demonstrate financial disadvantage and provide a written statement addressing the grant criteria. The funds must be used for the intended purpose and recipients will be required to sign a grant agreement to this effect.

Value: \$2,000 (split into two instalments of \$1,000 after the Study Period 2 and 5 census dates).

Application Closing Date: 18 March 2011
