



Bar Skills Training Program

Outline of the program:

This pre-vocational training program has been designed to provide the participants with a range of training and workplace experiences in the areas of:

- Occupational health and safety
- Person hygiene
- Customer service
- Responsible service of alcohol
- Product knowledge

The training will focus on the necessary skills required to get the participants 'job ready' before working in a bar or club.

Trainers appointed to deliver the pre-vocational program are fully accredited, have many years current industry experience and have extensive experience in delivering hospitality training to a diverse range of groups, including indigenous groups, disability groups, mature age and long termed unemployed.

This program has one accredited unit; the training will be conducted to a current industry standard. On successful completion of the program participants will be awarded a Statement of Attendance issued by William Angliss Institute of TAFE.
