



BASIC RIGGING

Structural steel erection, movement of plant or equipment by mechanical means, application & use of static lines & safety nets all require the skills of a Rigger.

With strict requirements on fall prevention systems when working at heights a rigger is necessary to provide safe application of these systems.

<p>At the completion of this course applicants will be able to carry out the duties of a basic rigger. Generally most Construction & Plant Maintenance duties will require the services of a rigger.
