The training enables attainment of the mandatory nationally recognised OHS induction training program for the registration of workers on construction sites to be registered by SafeWork SA

Application of the unit

This unit of competency supports the attainment of the basic OHS knowledge required prior to undertaking designated work tasks within any of the sectors within the construction industry.

The unit relates directly to the general induction training program specified by the *National Code of Practice for Induction Training for construction Work (ASCC 2006)* and the OHS regulations 2007, for the registration of workers on construction sites to be registered.
